Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

SERVICES, FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

1. Basic Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff (Required).....\$ 550.

This is a basic fee that we charge every family for our professional expertise in assisting them with their preferences. It includes a portion of our overhead, which includes taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses required to serve the public. Our charge includes, but is not limited to consultation with the family, administrative and clerical services, preparations of the death certificate for certification by the attending physician or coroner, local procurement of death certificate, preparation of required permits, filing the death certificate with appropriate agencies, and when necessary, notification to clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. *(This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations.)*

2. Preparation of Remains

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral or witness with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation.

- A) On site Refrigeration of unembalmed remains (first 5 days, or portion thereof).....\$ 200.
California Code of Regulations, Section 1223 C: An unembalmed body must be refrigerated if held longer than 24 hours
Additional refrigeration (each day, beyond 5 days) Additional 25.

- C) Embalming of Autopsied remains (or other cases requiring special care) Additional 300.
- D) Sanitary care (Optional).....200.
- E) Dressing and casketing of unembalmed remains.....200.

- H) Pacemaker Removal and Disposal (by a license embalmer)75.

(Scheduled I.D. Viewing – un-embalmed, up to 10 family members, up to 30 minutes)200.
- B) Saturday Weekend/Holiday Service or Viewing (Starting before 12:00 noon)..... Additional 500.
(Starting after 12:00 noon)..... Additional 750.
- C) Sunday Weekend/Holiday Service or Viewing (Starting before 12:00 noon)..... Additional 750.
(Starting after 12:00 noon) Additional 1000.

- I) Witness Cremation (Scheduled Full Cremation Process, Approximately 4 hours).....500.
- J) 1 Day Priority / Rush Cremation (Completed within 1 days after receipt of County Permit Issues)400.
- K) 2 Day Priority / Rush Cremation (Completed within 2 days after receipt of County Permit Issues)300.
- L) Priority / Rush Cremation (Completed within 3-5 days after receipt of County Permit Issues)200.
